Introduction

Ishaath Public School was established in 1994 to provide quality modern education to the students of Poonoor and its surroundings and affiliated to CBSE in 2003. We are privileged to extend our gratitude to A.P. Aboobacker Musliyar for his blessings, affection and patronage. Also, I remember Dr Abdul Hakim for his kind guidance and suggestions for the success of the vision and mission of Ishaath Public School.

MISSION

Our mission is through an outstanding teaching–learning techniques incorporating the latest technology, IPS will inspire students to achieve their academic and personal potential, become passionate, reflective learners, become caring global citizens and lead healthy, active and balanced lives.

ACADEMICS

During 2023-24, 41 students appeared for the CBSE class 10th exam with 100 % pass. 26 students scored above 75 %, 13 students scored more than 60%. Ms Fathima Shifa P K D/o of Sri. Basheer Pookkottu scored 467 marks, (93.4%) and stood first in the school.

This year 47 students will appear in the 10th std board exam.

The total number of students from classes 1 to 10 is 1302. In LKG and UKG the total number of kids is 303.

The following Scholastic examinations conducted during this year. They are PWT-1, PWT-2, Midterm, PWT-3, Annual examination is scheduled on March 13th of this year.

The open house for all grades was conducted at the appropriate time.

REMEDIAL TEACHING

Special sessions are in place to remove the learning blocks of children in our school. The extra period of 40 minutes is allocated for the same every day. Meanwhile, the bright children are guided for enrichment by the teachers according to the schedule. Pre board exams, night classes and several revision tests for grades 9 & 10 were conducted meticulously.

Wherever necessary, special classes are provided for class 10 students.

Guidance and Counselling

To provide emotional support to the students, IPS Poonoor has appointed a counsellor for guidance and counselling using scientific methods from LKG to class 10. School has arranged various talks by experts to motivate the children and parents.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
